

## Fellowship for a Clinical Researcher

We are seeking a clinical researcher who is motivated to launch his / her research career at the International Clinical Research Center of St. Anne's University Hospital in Brno, the Czech Republic (FNUSA – ICRC) within a research program promoting clinical research and beginning earliest in Q1 2018. The program is designed for two years with a regular yearly evaluation.

The program applicants are encouraged to prepare one page research proposal of their individual research interest matching with one of the research areas of FNUSA-ICRC teams (to see the list of teams and further information please visit <http://www.fnusa-icrc.org/en/research.html>). The research proposal should include the applicant's background, hypothesis, specific aims, experimental design and expected results. The best research proposals will be selected by an International Board of recognized researchers in early October 2017.

The program participants will receive a competitive start-up package including a salary for you and your colleague (nurse or research technician), a credit of EUR 200,- to publish in international journal and an opportunity to present at a conference or a workshop.
